Please find below a note of issues in rural east. If you would like to speak to any of the team we would be pleased to hear from you.

Headley, Box Hill, Mickleham & Westhumble.

Vehicles are still parking inconsiderately in the area of Box Hill and Westhumble railway station. Local officers have attended this location on several occasions and issued warning letters to the drivers. We also continue to patrol the area and monitor the situation.

We have received reports of a male calling at houses in rural areas pretending to be a neighbour who has recently moved into the area who has ordered a package and mistakenly given their address. The male then asks the resident to sign for the package on his behalf and he will call back to pick it up. We strongly advise that members of the public do not sign for goods as they may have been purchased with stolen credit/debit cards. Should someone similar call at your address, please call 0845 125 2222.

Theft of Horse Tack remains a problem in the Headley and Box Hill areas. Surrey Police can, if requested, mark any leather saddles with a unique reference. Should you be interested in this service please contact PC 2987 Jo Morris at Dorking Police Station.

Brockham, Betchworth & Buckland.

We have had a recent spate of burglaries in the area. Please be more mindful of home security. People are leaving their homes more easily accessible for criminals so please ensure that your doors are locked and that windows, even upstairs windows, are closed before leaving the house.

We have received several reports about off-road motorcycles using Lawrence Lane in Buckland in an anti-social manner. All users of motor vehicles using highways must have a valid licence, tax, MOT and insurance

Over the last month at weekends, Betchworth Golf Club was a victim of several theft and criminal damage offences; there were also a large number of empty alcohol containers found near the ruins of Betchworth Castle. If you have any

information on who is responsible for these offences please contact your local Neighbourhood Policing Team.

The Brockham and Betchworth areas continue to have regular visits from door to door sellers. The identification carried by these salesmen does not entitle them to sell goods door to door; a separate peddler's licence is required. Should you witness any people knocking on doors, please contact the Police on 0845 1252222 as soon as possible so that we can attend and deal with them.
